

SISTER RITA CLARE MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

The Sister Rita Clare Music Scholarship is designed to assist secondary school students who plan to pursue full-time studies in music or music education at a recognized post-secondary institute. The amount of this scholarship is \$800.00.

Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Applicants must be in Grade 12, in good academic standing, and enrolled in a school in the Cape Breton-Victoria Regional School Board.
- 2. Applicants must be accepted into a music or music education degree program, or certificate program at a recognized postsecondary institute or conservatory.
- 3. Applications must be completed according to the Application Requirements.

Application Requirements

1. Compose an application letter addressed to the *Sister Rita Clare Scholarship Committee*, dated, and signed. In your letter, include your views on music and/or music education, share your personal goals as a musician, and discuss your plans for participating in the field of music after completing your degree or program. You may also briefly discuss a few important musical highlights or accomplishments. Otherwise, details about your experience and training should be included in (2), your music résumé.

2. Submit a music résumé according to the suggested format listed below. Use any categories that apply to you. List items according to date, with the most recent first.

PRIVATE STUDY - Private teachers, your instrument(s), length of study with each

Examples:

2019-2021 Teacher's name, instrument of study, or voice, 2 years
2018 Teacher's name, instrument of study, or voice, 6 months

SCHOOL MUSIC COURSES - non-performance classes

Examples:

2020 IB Music Fall 2019 Music History

SCHOOL ENSEMBLES, CONCERTS, PRODUCTIONS, SCHOOL-RELATED PERFORMANCES.

Example:

2020 Concert Band, Choir, Jazz Band

COMMUNITY MUSIC and/or THEATRE GROUPS

PROFESSIONAL or SPECIAL PROJECTS, FESTIVALS, and OTHER MUSICAL EXPERIENCE

AWARDS and RECOGNITIONS

- 3. Provide two letters of recommendation from either your music teachers, conductors or directors, or other music professionals who have worked with you.
- 4. Enclose an official transcript from your high school.
- 5. Completed applications including all materials must be postmarked no later than **May 15**, or submitted by email no later than 11:59 pm that day.
